**CONDITIONS: READ THESE CONDITIONS PRIOR TO BURNING** (continued on page 2)

1. This permit is valid only on those days which are not prohibited by the Air Resources Board pursuant to Section 41855 of the Health & Safety Code or by the Yolo-Solano Air Quality Management District (Y-S AQMD).
2. **All burning must be approved and scheduled by the Y-S AQMD office. Call number listed above.**
3. All field crop stubble must be placed on the "ready to burn" list. **Call number listed above.**
4. On any day that burning is to be done, the **fire district must be notified** before ignition and the burning is to be conducted in accordance with the conditions specified below. Note: If your fire district is not a manned station, contact Yolo County Fire Control at (530) 666-8920 or Solano County Fire Control at (707) 421-7090 or Dixon area at (707) 678-7080. For east Davis call (530) 747-5400.
5. Burning ignition hours are 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for field stubble material (Sept. through Jan. 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.) and 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. or 1 hour before sunset, whichever is earlier, for other agricultural burning, unless otherwise specified by State Law, Fire District, or the Y-S AQMD.
6. The permit is valid only on land owned or legally controlled by permit holder and shall be available for inspection at the burn site.
7. Material shall be arranged to facilitate efficient burning and shall be free of petroleum waste, demolition waste, construction debris, tires, rubber products, materials containing tar, metal salvage, car bodies or parts and other non-agricultural crop materials.
8. The waste shall be dried as required, shall be free of visible moisture, and only ignited with approved devices. All field and range burning must be ignited by backfiring or strip firing into the wind unless approved otherwise by the Air Pollution Control Officer.
9. No burning will be allowed within 3 miles of a populated area when the wind direction is toward the populated area unless approved otherwise by the Air Pollution Control Officer.

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*Conditions continued:*

- 10. Permit holder will be held responsible for smoke impacting populated areas.
- 11. This permit may be revoked or suspended for violation of any conditions, misrepresentation, or as necessary for public safety.
- 12. Acreage burned during the calendar year in which this permit was issued is required to be prepaid based on the fee schedule established in District Rule 4.6. If acreage exceeds the amount listed on this permit, the difference must be paid to the District prior to a new permit being issued.

**WARNING:** Any person who violates the provisions of the Rules & Regulations or the California Health & Safety Code is guilty of a misdemeanor and is subject to a fine of not more than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) or imprisonment in the county jail of not more than nine months, or both, and the cost of putting out the fire.

The above statements are true to the best of my knowledge. I understand that permission to burn does not excuse the permit holder from liability in the event the fire creates a nuisance or hazard. I also understand that permit fees must be paid to validate this permit application.
