GENERAL INFORMATION

On July 9, 2008, the YSAQMD Board of Directors adopted District Rule 11.3, Agricultural Engine Registrations which requires each engine (excluding mobile equipment such as tractors) greater than 50 hp used in an agricultural operation to obtain a registration. On December 8, 2010 the YSAQMD Board of Directors adopted amendments to Rule 11.3 which established two additional criteria for applicable agricultural engines, remote location and residency. These criteria in turn allowed the creation of two new registration classifications, Low use and Intermittent use.

The District will use the registration process to enforce the requirements of the Airborne Toxic Control Measure (ATCM) promulgated by the California Air Resources Board (ARB). For more information on the engine emission standards, please contact the District.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE AGRICULTURAL ENGINE REGISTRATION APPLICATION FORM

1. **APPLICANT:** The agricultural registration can be issued to the owner or the operator of the engine. Whomever the registration is issued to will be responsible for complying with all applicable requirements. Please specify the name of the person, partnership, company, corporation, or agency to be named on and held responsible for the registration. The responsible official is an individual with the authority to certify that the source will comply with all District requirements and conditions set forth in a registration. Also, specify the main (or primary) site address for your operation.
2. **REGISTRATION(S) TO BE MODIFIED:** Identify the registration(s) by the registration number which is located on the registration certificate (bottom left corner, R-0xxxx-0xx) or by the registration sticker number on the engine. Check the registration modification you want and report the current hour meter reading and the date it was obtained. The official start point hour meter reading will be obtained by District staff when the unit is inspected and issued a new registration sticker.
 - a) **Requirements for Low, Intermittent & Emergency Use Registrations:**

Functional hours meters and reporting of annual engine usage hours is required for all three registration types. Low and Intermittent use engines cannot be operated or found deployed for operation within one-half mile of a school, hospital and/or residential area. Low use engines have limits for both annual and total hour usage. Intermittent use engines have a total hour usage limit. Emergency use engines are for back-up purposes and can only be used to provide electricity or perform mechanical work during an emergency when the primary system(s) is non-functional.

Low use: Engine is limited to a maximum of 200 hours/year and cumulative total hour limit of 2,400 hrs. There is no sunset date (only the 2,400 hour total limit).

Intermittent use: Engine has no annual limit but has a 2,000 hour cumulative total limit. Once the 2,000 hrs have been used, the engine must be permanently retired. Registrations for Tier 0 engines will expire 12/31/2020 regardless of the hours being utilized or not. Registrations of Tier 1 & Tier 2 engines will expire 12/31/2025.
3. **PROCESSING FEE:** A separate fee is required for each engine and must be included at the time of submittal. The fee is based on the schedules in District Rule 4.1. Registration renewal invoices issued in November cover the upcoming operational year. Engines seeking a modified registration are typically engines that have or are about to hit the compliance date for being removed from service and will not have been included on the annual renewal invoice. For such engines, the renewal fee must be paid along with the registration modification fee. Check your last renewal invoice or contact the District if you are unsure if payment of the renewal fee is needed or not. Make checks payable to Yolo-Solano Air Quality Management District (YSAQMD).
4. **SIGNATURE:** This application must be signed by the responsible official. An original signature is required, no photocopies/faxes.

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
